Weekly Price Summary for August 13, 2010

Some shortage has driven the upper range prices somewhat higher. There are reports of resistance to the rising cost of trim in the market place. Supply to demand ratio at this point has mitigated the effects this has had on the market.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.60 lb HHW to \$2.90 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.50 lb/HHW to \$2.90 lb/HHW.

OTM and those carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer has specific ranges for their markets.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices range from \$2.00 to 2.20 HHW.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
