Weekly Price Summary for August 27, 2010

The market has strengthened this week in response to the ever tightening supplies of finished Grade A bison. Grade A Slaughter prices broke \$3.00 this week. This is a 10 year high.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.80 lb HHW to \$3.00 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.75 lb/HHW to \$3.00 lb/HHW.

OTM and those carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer has specific ranges for their markets.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices range from \$2.00 to 2.20 HHW.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
