Weekly Price Summary for Dec 24, 2010

For the next week movement will be minimal in the market. All prices are remaining steady. Looking to 2011 the minimal numbers available for slaughter is causing concern.

Slaughter Markets

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$3.25 lb HHW to \$3.55 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$3.25 lb/HHW to \$3.40 lb/HHW.

Carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer will have specifications for the prices quoted.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices are averaging \$2.20 HHW

Live Markets

Prices are steady at an approximate average of \$2.20 At this time there is no price difference between bulls and heifers. The yearlings at \$2.00 -\$2.30LB
Bred heifers are in the \$2,500 to \$3,500 with good cows in the same range.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on.
Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc.
This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
