Weekly Price Summary for Feb 4, 2011

Supplies continue to be tight and reports indicate that carcasses are lighter than average. There is speculation that some animals are being held back for higher weights and prices.

Slaughter Markets

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$3.50 lb HHW to \$3.75 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$3.30 lb/HHW to \$3.65 lb/HHW.

Carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer will have specifications for the prices quoted.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices are averaging \$2.50 HHW

Live Markets

2010 bulls -\$2.10 to \$2.30 per lb. heifers -\$2.00 to \$2.10 per lb.

2009 bulls & feeder heifers \$2.00-\$2.10 per lb

2009 replacement quality heifers \$1,500-\$2,000

2008 Breds \$2,000 and up

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
