Weekly Price Summary for June 11, 2010

Prices were steady this week. Supplies will continue to tighten with potential upward pressure on prices. Middle cuts are now moving well and frozen inventory is low.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.55 to \$2.85 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.40 to \$2.70 lb/HHW.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices continue strong with the hot trim market. Prices range from \$1.65 to \$1.75 lb/HHW.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
