Weekly Price Summary for June 4, 2010

Tightening supplies, a softer dollar, and weather related difficulties in getting finished animals to processing have increased prices on top quality bison carcasses this week.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.55 to \$2.85 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.40 to \$2.70 lb/HHW.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices continue strong with the hot trim market. Prices range from \$1.65 - \$1.75 per pound HHW.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
