Weekly Price Summary for March 18, 2011

Prices continue steady. UTM Grade A heifers are close or at bull prices. As calving season approaches fewer slaughter cows available.

Slaughter Markets

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$3.50 lb HHW to \$3.75 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$3.50 lb/HHW to \$3.75 lb/HHW.

Carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer will have specifications for the prices quoted.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices are averaging \$2.50 HHW with sales to \$2.70

Live prices-too few reports to quote.

Reports do indicate that some buyers are becoming hesitant to purchase feeder animals in the current market.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
