Weekly Price Summary for May 21, 2010

A variety of factors including pressure from tightening supplies, a weakened dollar and increased movement on the middle cuts has marginally raised prices on top quality carcasses this week.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.50 lb HHW to \$2.65 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.40 lb/HHW to \$2.50 lb/HHW.

OTM and those carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted up to 15 cents a pound on the rail.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices continue strong with the hot trim market. Average price \$1.60 per pound HHW with higher sales reported.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
