### **Weekly Price Summary for May 7, 2010**

The demand and price of bison trim continues on its upward trend. However the price of middle cuts remain soft. Marketers are looking forward to warmer temperatures and a brisk BBQ season.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$2.50 lb HHW to \$2.60 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$2.35 lb/HHW to \$2.45 lb/HHW.

OTM and those carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted up to 15 cents a pound on the rail.

Slaughter cows and bulls are well over \$1.60 per pound HHW on average due to high trim demand and light offering.

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
