Weekly Price Summary for Oct 22, 2010

The market has remained steady this week. Supply is at an all time low and prices are at an all time high. Marketers state that they are finding some customer resistance. This is also impacting feeder bison pricing. Some feeders may reduce their numbers due to concerns over high investments.

UTM Grade A bison bulls in the desirable weight range, sold from \$3.00 lb HHW to \$3.45 lb/HHW.

UTM Grade A bison heifers in the desirable weight range were from \$3.00 lb/HHW to \$3.45 lb/HHW.

Carcasses not falling within the buyer's desirable weight range and parameters may be discounted. Each buyer will have specifications for the prices quoted.

Slaughter cows and bulls prices range from \$2.10 to 2.40 HHW.

Yearling feeder bison-\$1.80-\$2.00 live

Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis.
