Commentary

September live bison and meat prices moved down from the summer highs because of signs of consumer resistance in North America and Europe. Although demand remains strong for most cuts, there have been reports of inventory build-up. With the summer grilling season coming to an end, the demand for bison trim is showing some weakness.

As mentioned in previous reports, the supply of finished animals for processing continues to be tight with bison numbers being down and heifers being held back for breeding; however, marketers are reporting that they have been able to source required animals. Certain meat processors continue to evaluate their bison program at current prices while others continue to look for steady supplies of product. Although prices for live bison are expected to weaken relative to summer highs, they are expected to remain strong relative to year ago levels.

Nationally, federal slaughter was down 39% in the first 36 weeks of 2011 (week ending September 10, 2011) when compared to 2010 (7,211 animals in 2011 compared to 11,764 animals for 2010). Live bison exports to the U.S. are down by 29.5% - 11,181 for the first seven months of 2011 compared to 15,858 bison for the same period in 2010. The average price for Grade A bulls and heifers moved down from highs of \$4.10 - \$4.20 per pound to \$3.90 - \$4.00 per pound hot hanging weight. Mature bull prices in mid-September moved down from prices of over \$3.00 per pound to \$3.00 and under per pound.

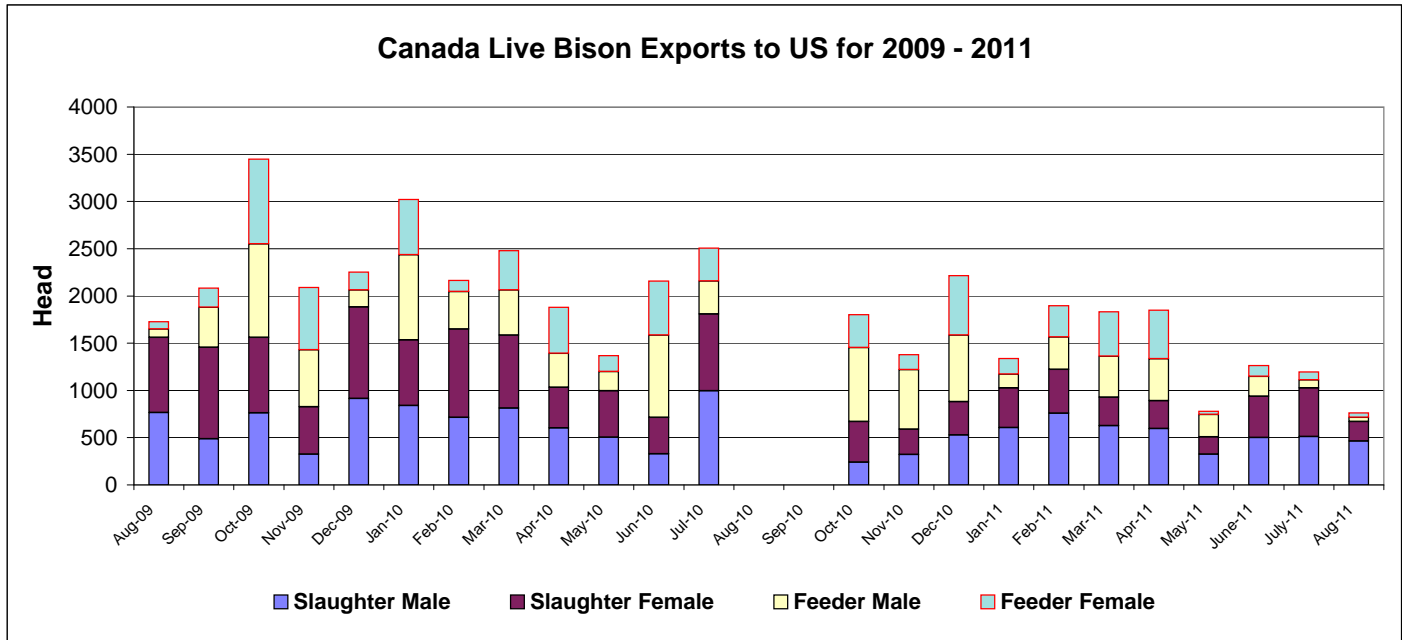
