Dr Thomas Olson is the past chairman of the Canadian Bison Association and currently serves as the chairman of the Conservation Committee of the CBA. He also serves as the chairman of the Bison Producers of Alberta. He has worked extensively with conservation organizations to promote the ecological restoration of bison.

Tom, his wife Carolyn and their 10 children have been ranching bison since 1993. His family ranches in several ecologically sensitive areas: Bragg Creek, Waterton Lakes National Park, Milk River Ridge, Cypress Hills and Duck Mountain Provincial Park.

The Olson Ranches have restored several thousand acres of native grass and have planted back over 1000 cultivated acres back to native grass. Products from the Olson Ranches are marketed under the name of "Olson's High Country Bison".

Tom is the senior partner of the international law firm of Olson Lemons LLP. He has a Master's and Doctor's degree in law.
