In memory of her wonderful life, husband Bernie Kot and her children and grandchildren Karen ((Dennis) Ashton & Kaitlyn Erickson, Brett, Layne & Bayden Kot and Wade (Melanie) Kot of K1 Bison Ranch, in remembrance of their beloved Liliane, have developed the Liliane Kot Memorial Scholarship. Each year a scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a selected individual. In addition each year a perpetual award is presented to the recipient who is able to keep the award for a year. An engraved gift is also given to the recipient.

Scholarship criteria

1. Applicants must either be active members or their families must be active members of the Canadian Bison Association and their respective Regional Association.
2. Applicants must be actively involved in some sector of the bison industry
3. Applicants must be attending or be accepted into post secondary education or training (2008 included). This may include but not limited to college, university, or trade programs. Applicants must provide supporting documentation

Once an applicant has determined that they meet the scholarship criteria they should forward a resume to the Canadian Bison Association office by November 1, 2009, detailing their activities and experiences. The recipient of the scholarship will be chosen by a selection committee. Selection will be based on the applicant's depth of character and commitment not academic scores or age. Areas given highest priority in the selection process are attendance and or involvement in a church or church ministry, involvement and commitment to school, community and volunteering, involvement in sports and employment experience.
