Weekly Price Summary for May 14, 2020

Canadian Finished Bison Prices Lower

With the Canadian dollar fluctuations, the global uncertainty, and the turmoil created by COVID-19, please confirm prices offered by buyers as they may change daily.

Prices offered by Canadian buyers start at \$3.50/lb. HHW for Grade “A” bison bulls with few sales reported. Prices offered for heifers start at \$3.50/lb. HHW. Check with buyers as prices may be adjusted for carcass weights and quality. There is ample supply of finished animals.

U.S. buyers are paying \$3.60 US HHW for prime bulls from Canada for slaughter in the U.S. where slaughter times have been booked. Heifers are being purchased at \$3.40 /lb. HHW U.S. – again where slaughter times have been booked. Returns to the producers are dependent on exchange rates, quality, transportation, and export costs.

Older cows and bulls are being priced at \$3.00 to \$3.50 Canadian HHW.

***Producers should research the parameters on which the prices are based. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist producers in comparing prices on an equivalent basis. ***
