Weekly Price Summary for April 16, 2020

Canadian Finished Bison Prices Soften

With the Canadian dollar fluctuations, the global uncertainty, and the limited availability of slaughter space, please confirm prices offered by buyers as they may change daily.

Prices offered by Canadian buyers range from \$4.00 – \$4.50/lb. HHW for Grade “A” bison bulls while prices offered for heifers range from \$4.00 - \$4.40/lb. HHW with sale subject to a market for the meat products.

U.S. buyers are paying up to \$4.15/lb. US HHW for prime bulls from Canada for slaughter in the U.S. where slaughter times have been booked. Heifers are being purchased at up to \$3.80/lb. HHW U.S. – again where slaughter times have been booked. Heavier carcasses may be discounted. Returns to the producers are dependent on exchange rates, quality, transportation and export costs.

Older cows and bulls are being priced at \$3.00 to \$3.50 Canadian HHW.

*****Producers should research the parameters on which the prices are based. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist producers in comparing prices on an equivalent basis. *****
