Weekly Price Summary for November 14, 2019

Canadian Finished Bison Prices Stable

With the Canadian dollar fluctuations, please confirm prices offered by buyers as they may change daily.

Canadian buyers are offering \$4.80 – \$5.00/lb. HHW for Grade “A” bison bulls with sales reported to \$5.25/lb. HHW. Prices are being driven by US demand and exchange rates favoring the U.S. Carcasses that do not fall within buyers’ specifications may be discounted. U.S. buyers are offering \$3.85 - 4.15/lb. US HHW for prime bulls. Heavier carcass bulls may be discounted. Returns to the producers are dependent on exchange rates, quality, and export costs.

Grade “A” bison heifers in the desirable weight range are selling for \$4.60 - \$4.80 /lb. HHW with some sales to \$5.10/lb. HHW. US buyers are offering \$3.60 - \$3.80/lb. HHW in US dollars with some sales to \$4.05/lb. HHW. Producer returns are dependent on exchange rates, quality, and export costs.

Older cows and bulls are being priced at \$3.00 to \$3.25 HHW on limited sales.

***Producers should research what parameters the prices are based on. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery, weight ranges, age etc. This will assist them in comparing prices on an even basis. ***
