## Bison Marketplace – July 2024

From January 1, 2024 to September 14, 2024, 5,507 head of bison were slaughtered at federally inspected plants in Canada. This is 7.9% higher than the 5,104 slaughtered in the same time period in 2023. In the United States, 52,857 bison were slaughtered from January 1 through to August 31, 2024. This is up 7% from what was slaughtered during the same time period in 2023 (49,386 were slaughtered last year during the same time period).

Prices for prime finished bison bulls for the Canadian market have been pushing slightly upward, with recent sales as high as \$5.75/lb hot hanging weight, with heifers as high as \$5.50. Prices for Canadian Bison headed to the US market \$4.55 (USD) and \$4.30 (USD) for bulls and heifers respectively. Note that to ship to US market, shippers are responsible for the currency risk, shipping costs, vet check and admin costs.

According to the most recent USDA data that includes numbers to the end of August, 7574 slaughter males were shipped from Canada, 9331 slaughter females, 4166 feeder males and 3270 feeder females. In contrast, in the same time period in 2023, 8331 slaughter males were shipped from Canada, 9546 slaughter females, 4240 feeder males and 3917 feeder females. On a percentage basis, this is a decrease of 9% of slaughter males, a decrease of 2.3% of slaughter females, a decrease of 1.7% of feeder males and a decrease of 17% of feeder females. Fewer animals are headed across the border.

**September 2024 Prices:** Prices are strong based on seasonal limited supply and steady demand.




## The Canadian Bison Industry by the Numbers.....

On another note, the 2021 Canadian Census of Agriculture data was released on May 11, 2022. Nationally, the number of bison farms and ranches reporting bison was up 1.4% from 2016 levels. The number of bison on farms and ranches in 2021 was reported to have increased by over 25% within the past five years. According to the data, the average bison herd size increased to 151 head (from 122 head in 2016).

The number of farms and ranches held relatively steady since 2016 (up by 14 farms); some provinces reported increases (Ontario and Alberta both up by 6.1%) and some reported declines (Quebec down by 23.5% and British Columbia down 12.7%).

Excluding the Atlantic Region, the only province to report a decrease in the number of bison was Manitoba (-16.4%), while British Columbia reported the most significant increase (+128.9%); more than doubling the 2016 provincial herd size.
