Prices for finished animals continue to be strong with tight supply - prime bulls selling for up to \$6.00/lb HHW for harvesting in Canada and up to \$6.20/lb HHW Canadian delivered to the US market. Heifers are about 30 cents lower. Adjustments must be made for export processing and transportation costs for animals being shipped to the U.S.

In the U.S. market, prices for finished bulls have pushed \$465/cwt USD with heifers \$15 - \$30/cwt USD lower.

At the first commercial bison auction there where just under 300 head. Quality was variable. Good bull calves reached \$4.00/lb with heifers at \$3.40/lb. Yearling bulls were up to \$3.25/lb with heifers at \$2.70. On December 5, 2023, seventeen 900 lb. bulls sold for \$3.62/lb.

Producers should research the parameters on which the prices are based. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery transportation costs, weight ranges, age, exchange rates etc. This will assist producers in comparing prices on an equivalent basis.
