

Weekly Price Summary for March 14th, 2025

With the Canadian dollar fluctuations, and market uncertainty please confirm prices offered by buyers as prices may change.

**Mature Bulls and Cows Over 30 months of age.

Prices for finished animals continue to be strong with tight supply - prime bulls selling for up to \$6.50/lb HHW for harvesting in Canada and up to \$6.95/lb HHW Canadian delivered to the US market. Heifers are about 30 cents lower. Adjustments must be made for export processing and transportation costs for animals being shipped to the U.S.

In the U.S. market, prices for finished bulls have pushed \$485/cwt USD with heifers \$15 - \$30/cwt USD lower.

At a commercial bison auction the week of March 7th, 500 pound bull calves sold between \$4.53 and \$4.58 a pound, and 450 pound heifer calves sold between \$376 and \$3.90 a pound. A lot of 20 cows sold at \$2.41

On February 8th an individual farm sold 17 breeding males and 39 bred heifers via online auction. The bulls ranged from \$8,000 to \$22,000. The bred heifers all sold for \$6,325 per animal.

At a large commercial bison auction the first week of February, 2024 weaned bull calves, weighing between 475 and 575 pounds and averaged \$5.29/lb. Female calves that averaged between 485 and 545 pounds sold on average for \$4.48/lb. Included in these figures were some males that sold as high as \$5.81/lb and some heifers that sold at a high as \$4.59.

Producers should research the parameters on which the prices are based. Parameters such as Canadian or US delivery transportation costs, weight ranges, age, exchange

rates etc. This will assist producers in comparing prices on an equivalent basis.
