CANADIAN BISON JUNIOR JUDGING PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- The Canadian Bison Junior Judging Program is designed to encourage and mentor youth in the Bison industry. The Junior Judging Program will be held in conjunction with the Canadian National Bison Show & Sale and Canadian Western Agribition.
- Contestant's family must be members in good standing of the Canadian Bison Association
- All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully. These are available online @ http://www.agribition.com or contact the CBA office for a hard copy.
- The Canadian Bison Association, its officers, agents or employees, assume no responsibility. Waivers must be signed by parent or guardian in order for entry to be accepted.
- Class Entry: The Canadian National Bison Show Junior Judging Program is open to ages 7-21, as of Nov 1, 2018 The Age brackets are as follows:

Junior: 7-10 years

Intermediate: 11-14 years Senior: 15-21 years

Criteria:

The judge for the event will present their opinion on an ideal animal, and what they look for in a breeding bull, and replacement female. The contestants will have the opportunity to take notes, and ask questions.

The judge will announce when the competition begins, and the contestants will have 20 minutes for each class, to complete their judging cards with written reasons. Junior contestants will only be required to place the animals, no written reasons are necessary. Parent or outside help is discouraged during the 40 minutes. All judging cards will be returned to the judge upon completion.

Contestants will judge a set of 4 bulls and a set of 4 females. There will be a sign hung on the gate of each animal in the judging competition to clearly identify each animal. Judging contestants will not be in the pen with the animal at any point.

Contestants will also be presenting oral reasons and placings to the judge at the completion of the live judging. Contestants will have their judging cards for reference.

Judging cards will be marked and graded by the event judge.	Points will be assigned for placings.	Points will also be assigned for oral
reasons. Total points will determine the category placings for	each age category.
